

THE ENVIRONMENT

Lensbury adopts a pro-active approach to environmental issues and is working hard to reduce its carbon foot-print. Measures taken include:

REDUCE CONSUMPTION

- In meeting rooms, water machines have replaced bottle water to reduce glass bottles used on the site
- Waterless urinals were successfully trialled at Lensbury in 2006, with roll-out completed in 2007
- Green transport plan including bike racks, changing facilities and large lockers to accommodate helmets to encourage cycling
- At peak conference times, a free shuttle service to Teddington station to encourage use of public transport rather than driving
- Use of energy efficient technologies and energy saving devices, including energy saving bulbs
- Staff and customers are encouraged to photocopy double-sided

RECYCLING

- Waste paper, cardboard and toners
- Glass
- Lensbury has a water borehole and management system to abstract water in the evening and night, maintaining our turf surfaces in a water efficient way.
- Under our planned tree maintenance programme, all wood from felled trees is chipped and re-used. All felled trees are replaced

RE-USE

- For staff drinks, Lensbury has a 'no poly cups' policy – Lensbury provides travel mugs for staff to re-use for cold and hot drinks
- Wherever possible, paper is re-used on reverse before re-cycling

Please support us by adopting environmentally friendly practices whilst at Lensbury:

- 1. Use the paper recycling bins in the rooms**
- 2. Photocopy double sided, if possible**
- 3. Re-use your 'poly cup' for water refills**
- 4. Switch lights off when not in the room, or not necessary**
- 5. Switch off equipment when not in use**
